A total of 960 students enrolled in the Guaranteed Results[©] Programme since it started in December 2003. 350 students enrolled in the programme for 2007 intake. Out of which, 30% who are generally weak students, passed the PSLE and progressed to Normal Academic. 65% achieved Express Stream and this is an improvement from 60% for last year's cohort.

Features of the Guaranteed Results© Programme:

- Advisory Board consisting of teachers and Head of Departments (HODs) with more than 5 years' experience, to ensure that a wider perspective is taken into account in developing, reviewing and assessing the curriculum and its applications.
- Bursary Award for PSLE which rewards the top five PSLE students in MERCUTM based on their aggregates. Recipients can expect to be presented with up to \$2000.
- Term tests are given at the end of each term based on topics that have been taught
- Motivational and revision workshops will be conducted for students
- Scheme of Work used by tutors as a guide for their lessons.
- Practical approach to Mathematics and Science, through fun and educational activities: merQTMMatics and merQTMLab.
- Small tutor-student ratio of 1:8 to allow for better monitoring of students' performance

Each student in MERCUTM tuition programme will be given **progress reports** detailing their term tests and mock examinations results. Scheme of Work (SOW) will also be given to the tutors, which serves as a guideline for them to cover the weekly topics stated in the SOW and ensures that lessons will be more organised.
